"PK Graphics is undergoing major growth in all facets of print jobs including high quality postcards and flyers, brochures, books and other promotional and corporate needs, however we will never forget that we got here by helping small businesses get started including the music industry executives, nightclub managers and promoters that make South Beach such an international hotspot," said Paredes. "By expanding our offices, adding more space and staff as well as opening our new PK Express concept store for walk-in business, we will be able to accommodate the growth in our national and local accounts all from our own printing plant in Pompano Beach." PK Graphics currently employs 140 people throughout South Florida.

PK Graphics, is moving into a brand new 7,000 square-foot corporate office on 420 Lincoln Road, Miami Beach. The new office will house its customer service, graphic design, shipping and logistics and corporate staff. The company is currently located in the same building.

PK Express - a new PK concept designed by Parades will open on South Beach. PK Express is designed to provide not only the quickest printing turnaround time in the business, but also some of the most competitive prices available to walk-in and small business customers, added Parades.

PK Express will be open from 9 am to midnight and can take scheduled or emergency orders. Any order put in between 9 a.m. and midnight has a guaranteed printing turnaround and delivery time by 7 p.m. the next business day, made possible by the state-of-the-art printing facility that handles all of the PK Graphics production.

PK Graphics is evaluating other outlets in South Florida and elsewhere in the US for the PK Express concept store, all of which would utilize PK Graphics' Pompano Beach printing plant, added Parades.

PK Graphics handles all print production at its 14,000 square foot printing plant located in Pompano Beach. After ten years of operation, PK Graphics has perfected high quality 24-hour turnaround printing techniques to allow for staggering production capabilities. Utilizing two Six-Color Heidelberg Speedmaster printing presses with In-Line UV that run 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and can make 10,000 impressions on 40-inch sheets per hour. In addition, the Pompano facility has four Polar Digital Cutters; so all jobs are cut to exact specifications.

PK Graphics has one of the most advanced pre-press departments, with a Creo Trendsetter 800 to create impressions on press plates, a Kodak Polychrome that turns the plates into positives for output. In addition to owning the presses, PK Graphics maintains its own shipping and logistics facilities to ensure the company delivers on its 24-hour turnaround promise. To meet this commitment, PK Graphics is one of the largest printing customers for both UPS and Delta Airlines.

The firm's pre- and post-press capabilities and shipping logistics enable PK Graphics to handle large scale work, at fractions of the cost of other mass quantity facilities with no compromise in quality.
